


Set up POP3/IMAP email - Apple iPad Pro 11 (2020)

1 Before you start

Make sure you have the following information: 1. Your email address 2. Password 3. Username Internet must be set up before you start this guide.


2 Select Settings




3 Scroll to and select Passwords & Accounts and select Add Account



4 Select Other




5 Select Add Mail Account




6 Enter the required information and select Next


7 Select POP and enter email information for INCOMING MAIL SERVER
